2011 USTA Middle States- Philadelphia District Club of the Year

Bryn Mawr Delaware Valley Tennis in Bryn Mawr, Pennsylvania was created in the spring of 2006 having merged the Bryn Mawr Racquet Club and Delaware Valley Tennis Academy. Bryn Mawr Racquet Club was built by the Goodman and D'Angeli families in the fall of 1976 on the site of the Hammond's Mill. During the tennis boom of the 70's and early 80's, Bryn Mawr Racquet was considered one of the premier indoor facilities with its unique Country French design using materials from the Mill, dating back to the early 1900's, to construct the notable, rustic lounge. The club's high-end pro shop and naturally lighted courts suited the tastes of its Main Line customers. Delaware Valley Tennis Academy was created in Wayne, Pennsylvania, during the early 1980's by John Palumbo and Richard Gilginas. As a direct descendant of the Bollettieri Academy, Delaware Valley Tennis Academy (DVTA) wanted to take tennis instruction to a new level in the Northeast. Eventually Gregory Ranieri bought the rights to the academy and moved it to Bryn Mawr in the late 1980's. DVTA, as it is referred to, has developed many juniors who have succeeded on the high school, collegiate and even professional level. DVTA's junior and adult programs are conducted at its Bryn Mawr facility along with its clinics and camps at the Radnor Racquet Club and Villanova University locations. 10 and Under Rules as of January 2012: According to the USTA

In a decision that will fundamentally change the future landscape of tennis in the United States, the USTA has passed new rules governing competition for 10-and-under tennis tournaments. The new rules require that 10-and-under tournaments be played using slower-moving and lower-bouncing balls on smaller courts and utilizing shorter, lighter racquets. This move follows the International Tennis Federation's proposed rule change and will take effect on Jan. 1, 2012. It applies to all USTA-sanctioned events for children 10 and under. The specifications for the revised system hold that all tournaments for those ages 9-10 be played on 60-foot courts using orange low-compression tennis balls and regulation nets (3 feet at the center) or, for those more experienced and more skilled players, on 78-foot courts with green lower-compression balls. Tournaments for those 8 and under are to be played on 36-foot courts using red foam balls and nets at a height of 2 feet, 9 inches.
